PLANNED GIVING

Planned Giving can also be part of a total financial plan for you. By including us in your estate plan, you can significantly support an educational and environmental non-profit resource while retaining benefits for yourself and achieve your own philanthropic and charitable giving goals.

Planned Giving allows you to provide for Turtle Ridge Wildlife Center by giving assets and retaining the income for you and/or for someone else.

Planned Giving brings you considerable tax advantages, including income, gift and estate tax charitable deductions, and, in most cases, avoidance of capital gain tax.

Planned Giving provides you with effective management of your resources if you choose to make your gift with real estate, appreciated securities or closely held stock.
